



PARALYMPIC TABLE TENNIS REGULATIONS

Last update 26.06.2026

1. Organization

- a. The Paralympic Committee of the 22nd Maccabiah will be responsible for the Paralympic Table Tennis competitions of the 22nd Maccabiah.
- b. The Paralympic Table Tennis competitions will be conducted according to the rules of the IPC INTERNATIONAL PARALYMPIC COMMITTEE and the ITTF.
- c. Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee of the 22nd Maccabiah, and is registered for the Paralympic Table Tennis competitions.
- d. Participation in the competition is open to athletes with disability categories TT1-TT10.
- e. Athletes without an official international disability classification can apply for a classification in Israel before the competitions. All medical documentations need to be submitted in advance and confirm that the minimum criteria have been met.

2. Venues and times

- a. The sport department of the 22nd Maccabiah will determine the venues and timetables of the Paralympic Table Tennis competitions and teams will be notified accordingly.

3. System of competition

- a. The competition will be held in two categories:
 1. Wheelchairs- disability categories T1-T5
 2. Standing- disability categories T6-T10
- b. A tournament will be held in each category with 8 players signed into two groups in the preliminary stage.
- c. The two best players of each group will qualify for the second round that will be held in a knock-out system for the 1-4 rankings.
- d. The two players that ranked at the bottom of the preliminary groups will play in a knock-out system for the ranking 5-8.

4. Judges

The Paralympic Committee will appoint the referees of the competition.

5. General

- a. These regulations are but one part of the complete 22nd Maccabiah Regulations, and must be read along with the instructions found in "Basic Regulations and Disciplinary Procedures".
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the regulations written here and those appearing in the "Basic Regulations", the regulations written here will apply and be binding.
